Memorandum of Understanding

This Memorandum of Understanding is made and executed on November-2017 at Hyderabad.

This document represents an agreement between

R.B.V.R.R.WOMEN'S COLLEGE, Narayanaguda, Hyderabad-500027, a unit of Hyderabad Mahila Vidya Sangham, (HMVS), a non-profit education society having its office at Narayanaguda, Hyderabad, Telangana State, INDIA (herein after referred to as RBVRR Women's College) which expression shall unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof be deemed to mean and include its successors and assigns

Being the First Part
AND

Modern Architects of Rural India a not for Profit Organization incorporated under the provisions of the Societies Registration Act, 2000, that is recognized as nonprofit entity by Govt. of India, having its principal office at Situated at No. 21 Jupiter Colony, Sikh Road, Secunderabad - 500 006 and Represented by Mr. Ramisetty Murali Chief Functionary Officer hereinafter referred as "MARI"

Being the Second Part

Whereas R.B.V.R.R.WOMEN'S COLLEGE has agreed to collect and give away the dry recyclable waste generated in its college and form Swachh WOW Hyderabad Chapter.

1. **NOW THIS MOU WITNESSETH AS UNDER:**

This is an agreement for a synergic alliance between R.B.V.R.R.WOMEN'S COLLEGE and MARI for the social cause of recycling of Dry Waste and creating sustainable livelihoods to the waste collectors/rag pickers.

2. **Time period:** This MOU shall be for a period of one year commencing from the date of signing of this MOU.

3. **Roles and Responsibilities of R.B.V.R.R.WOMEN'S COLLEGE:**

1. To ensure source segregation of dry and wet waste at College premise through its housekeeping staff and Students must propagate the source segregation.
2. The franchisee of WOW will collect dry recyclable waste separately and bring to the Dry Resource Collection Centre (DRCC) without any spillage.
3. R.B.V.R.R.WOMEN'S COLLEGE shall form Swachh WOW Hyderabad Chapter in the college with Student Volunteers and adopt nearby Schools or Colonies to promote Source Segregation through student volunteers.
4. R.B.V.R.R.WOMEN'S COLLEGE shall motivate students to bring dry recyclables like paper, plastic, metal etc. from their home and donate to WOW initiative.
5. R.B.V.R.R.WOMEN'S COLLEGE will put up color coded bins for waste segregation at different points in College premises.

4. **Roles and Responsibilities of MARI:**

1. MARI will train the students and housekeeping staff on source segregation and through them inculcate the habit of source segregation among the other students.
2. MARI will accept all the dry recyclable waste as enlisted in the Annexure-1 and sort out the different categories recyclables and bale the same for further recycling.
3. MARI will organize sorting of the dry waste into different categories, .baling, and appropriate disposal of dry waste.
4. MARI shall coordinate with ITC and undertake necessary measures for dispatch of the sorted recyclables for recycling at its own cost.
5. WOW franchisee will make payment to R.B.V.R.R.WOMEN'S COLLEGE directly into their accounts for the dry recyclable waste collected against the accurate weightment and the type or category of the dry waste. The payment

shall be made no later than 15 days from the date of purchase of dry waste from the waste collector. Franchisee on the request of R.B.V.R.R.WOMEN'S COLLEGE may give New Notebooks and Stationery against the value of dry recyclable waste lifted.

5. Performance of Obligations

1. The details laid out in this MOU, notwithstanding the essence and spirit of this MOU is an understanding between R.B.V.R.R.WOMEN'S COLLEGE and MARI.
2. Any notice or other communication under or in connection with this agreement shall be in writing in the English language and shall be delivered personally or sent by way of e-mail to the party due to receive the notice or communication at its address set out in this contract or such other address as either party may specify by notice in writing to other.

6. Execution of this Agreement shall be deemed to be

- a) A confirmation by both the parties that no benefit, either in cash or kind has been provided by either party to the other party or to any officer or employee, or any relative/ associate of any officer or employee of either party or of any of their associate institutions/companies in order to enter into this Agreement, and

- b) An undertaking by both the parties not to provide any benefit, either in cash or kind to any officer/employee/relative/associate of any officer or employee of either party as reward or consideration either for entering into this MOU or other matter relating to this Agreement.

7. Other Terms:

Force Majeure: Neither party shall be liable for damages for any delay or failure to perform its obligations here under, if such delay or failure is due to reasons beyond the control of the concerned party including without limitation, strikes, riots, wars, fires, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, unusually severe weather, earth quakes, explosions, acts of God or state or any public enemy or acts mandated by applicable laws, regulation or order, whether valid or invalid, of any Governmental body.

- 8. Dispute Resolution:** It is understood by both the parties that this Agreement is for a social cause and not to make any profit out of the understanding. The Parties covenant that they will comply with all applicable laws and regulations in their conduct pursuant to this Agreement. Any dispute arising out of this Agreement shall be first attempted to settle amicably between the parties.

9. Arbitration

Any dispute which is not resolved amicably shall be finally settled by binding arbitration in respect to the matters concerning to the MOU with the Sole Arbitrator to be appointed by the mutual consent of both the parties. The Parties agree that the decision or award resulting from arbitration shall be final and binding upon the Parties.

Pending the submission of and/or decision on a dispute, the Parties shall continue to perform their respective obligations under this Agreement without prejudice to a final adjustment in accordance with such arbitration award

- 10. Governing and Jurisdiction:** This Agreement is subjected to the Jurisdiction of Courts at Hyderabad.

- Both the parties shall agree that it will not make use of, disseminate, or in any way disclose any confidential information to any person, firm or business. Furthermore, the existence of any discussions, negotiations or agreements in progress between the parties shall not be released to any form of public media without written approval of both parties.





11. Amendments
