Narcotics Control Bureau (NCB), Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs is the nodal agency for the implementation of the provisions of NDPS Act, 1985. NCB Sub Zone, Hyderabad has jurisdiction of the states of Andhra Pradesh and Telangana.
