About the College

Shaping Minds Since 1954

- **Raja Bahadur Venkata Rama Reddy Women's College (RBVRRWC)**, commonly known as Reddy College, was founded in 1954 by Hyderabad Mahila Vidhya Sangham, a non-profit organisation dedicated to empowering women through quality education. It stands as the second oldest women's college in Hyderabad, rooted in the vision of Sri Raja Bahadur Venkata Rama Reddy, the former Commissioner of Police of Hyderabad State, who saw modern education as critical for women's advancement.
- This vision was brought to life by key figures like Sri Burgula Ramakrishna Rao, the first Chief Minister of Hyderabad State, along with other pioneers including Shri Madapati Hanumantha Rao and Shri K.V. Ranga Reddy, who championed women's education in the region. Their legacy continues through the college's Governing Council, composed of distinguished jurists, academicians, and eminent personalities.
- The college has hosted several notable dignitaries: Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru laid its foundation stone in 1954, Dr. S. Radha Krishnan inaugurated its building in 1955, and Smt. Indira Gandhi opened the hostel in 1965. More recently, former President Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam addressed students during the college's Golden Jubilee in 2005, marking another milestone.
- Affiliated with Osmania University and recognized by the UGC, R.B.V.R.R.W.C gained autonomous status in 1989 and was awarded an "A" grade by NAAC in its 5th accreditation cycle in 2023. The college boasts a sprawling campus with six buildings, 48 classrooms, 31 science labs, and a hostel for rural students.
- R.B.V.R.R.W.C offers 18 undergraduate programs under the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS), alongside various skill enhancement and career-oriented certificate courses. Postgraduate programs include MBA, M.Sc. Mathematics with Computer Science, Organic Chemistry, Computer Science, Data Science, and Nutrition and Dietetics, reflecting its commitment to comprehensive women's education and empowerment.

ELIGIBILITY for ADMISSION TO UG PROGRAMMES

- Women candidates of Indian Nationality/Persons of Indian Origin (PIO)/Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) Card Holders; and those allotted by Osmania University under “Foreign Student” category is eligible for admission.
- Candidate should have applied for admission in the prescribed form and fulfilled all the eligibility conditions.
- Candidates should have passed Intermediate (+2) examination or any equivalent examination as recognized by the Government of Telangana, with a minimum aggregate of 40% marks (36% in case of SC/ST candidates) in the optional subjects.
- Candidates of any stream from (Social Science/Science/Commerce) in Intermediate are eligible for admission to B Com. However, candidates who have studied commerce as an optional subject will be given preference. Sixty Percent (60%) of the total number of available seats in B. Com shall be reserved for the candidates who studied and passed the qualifying examination with Commerce as the main subject.
- Candidates of any stream from (Social Science/Science/Commerce) in Intermediate are eligible for admission to B A and BBA Programs.
- Candidates who passed the Intermediate examination, or its equivalent, in ‘one attempt’ shall be given preference in admission compared to those who passed in compartmental. Candidates who have passed the qualifying examination compartmentally shall be considered for admission, only after all the candidates who passed in single attempt under the respective category of Undergraduate Course are accommodated.
- Students from BPC background can apply for the following courses - B. Sc (MBTC, FNBC, FnZC, BtCFs, FsCCA, FsZC, MLT).
- Students from MPC and Mathematics background can apply for the following courses - B. Sc (MPCs, MSCs, MSDs, AI&ML)

Rules of Reservation:

a) Local: 85% of the available seats in each Programme shall be reserved for the local candidates as specified in the Telangana State Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admissions) Order,1974(G.O.No.646, dated 10.7.1979, and generally referred to as the Presidential Order, 1974).

b) Statutory: Admissions in each Programme are made in accordance with the following statutory reservations prescribed by the Government, and as per the rules in vogue.

In addition to the above, 10% of the seats are allotted for economically Weaker Section (EWS)

c) In case the required numbers of eligible candidates are not available in a given reserved category, the vacant seats shall be filled by candidates from other categories (by internal sliding), as per the rules, so as to maintain the overall percentage of statutory reservations prescribed by the Government. If seats remain vacant in a reserved category even after internal sliding, they shall be filled by candidates from open category.

d) EWS:10% of the seats are allotted under EWS quota. Persons who are not covered under the scheme of reservation for SCs, STs and BCs and whose family has gross annual income below Rs. 8.00 lakhs (Rupees Eight Lakhs only) can apply for EWS quota.

APPLICATION for ADMISSIONS

Candidates should apply for admission online from the college website www.rbvrrwomenscollege.ac.in

- Candidates desirous of applying for more than one program (B A / B Sc / B Com / BBA) should apply separately by paying Rs.500/- for each program.
- Candidates should pay the prescribed 'Registration Fee' of Rs.500/-for a program, and submit the application form in the college along with the Xerox copies of the following certificates.
- Pass Certificate of the Intermediate or its equivalent examination, SSC, CBSE, ICSE, issued by the competent authorities, indicating the date of birth (DoB) of the applicant.
- Consolidated Memorandum of Marks obtained in the qualifying examination.
- Transfer Certificate issued by the institution where the candidate studied last.
- Proof of Study in the past seven (7) years immediately preceding the qualifying examination in order to claim Local status
- Caste Certificate issued by the concerned M.R.O if claiming reservation under BC/ SC/ ST quota.
- NCC/ Sports/CAP/ PH certificate issued by the competent authority, if claiming reservation under any of these quota(s).
- Income Certificate of the Parent issued by the concerned M.R.O for the current financial year.
- A Copy of the Aadhar Card.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- a) The candidates will be selected for admission in each category of open and other statutory reservations based on merit at the qualifying examination.
- b) Percentage of aggregate marks obtained in the qualifying examination shall be the basis for determining the merit of the candidate. In case of tie, the candidate who got higher marks in English will be preferred. In case of a further tie, the person who is older in age will be selected.
- c) The provisional list of selected candidates for admission shall be displayed on the Notice Board in the College, and also on the College website (www.rbvrrwomenscollege.ac.in). No separate and individual intimation will be sent to the applicants.
- d) The candidates selected for admission may meet the admission committee members for clarification of doubts if any.
- e) Selected candidates should submit their original certificates in the College Office for verification. Admission to the first year 3-YDC shall be granted only after verification of those certificates.
- f) The College reserves the right to cancel the admission at any stage, if the information (Certificates and documents) submitted by the candidates is found False/Fake.
- g) The Principal of the college reserves the right to stop the candidate from appearing in the End Semester Examination if she does not put in a minimum of seventy five percent (75%) attendance. However, 10% attendance may be condoned on valid medical grounds.

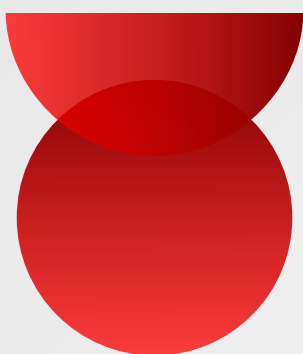

Business Management and Business Administration

Commerce

Zoology, Microbiology & MLT

The departmental museum houses rare specimens like Protopterus and bird eggs. Students receive research-focused training in microbiology and diagnostics. The department regularly hosts workshops and training sessions, often collaborating with IITs to enhance scientific skills.

Mathematics and Statistics

The department was the first in the state to introduce Mathematica for Mathematics practicals and Minitab-19 for Statistics. It has designed curricula for B.Sc students using Sagemath for Mathematics and MS-EXCEL, Minitab-19, TORA, Python, SPSS, and R software for Statistics practicals and projects.



Physics

The department focus on Quantum Mechanics and Condensed Matter Physics, equipped with the latest laboratory instruments. Starting from the academic year 2022-23, a Mobile Laboratory was introduced to enhance practical learning.



Computer Science

The department focuses on experiential learning and practical skills. It manages the college's intranet and internet, supporting the College Management System. It also runs digital literacy outreach and orientation programs and hosts a dedicated Centre for Digital Literacy.



Chemistry and Forensic Science

This college is a pioneer in Southern India and the first women's college in India to offer Forensic Science as an optional undergraduate subject. It features a well-equipped Centralized Research Instrumentation Laboratory and is recognized as a research center by Osmania University.
